

### INFORMATION

#### **REGISTRATION**

Team captains are asked to register their players at the Tournament Office at the club house on Monday, 8 July from 9:00 a.m. till 12:00 p.m (noon).

#### CATERING

Breakfast is included in the accommodation and will be served from 6:00 a.m.

Lunches will be served at Kraków Valley G&CC. The price of the lunch voucher is 85 PLN / 110 PLN / 130 PLN (20 EUR / 26 EUR / 30 EUR) per person per day and depends on the chosen option. The menu will be provided to participants in advance. Vouchers will be available upon registration and on all championship days. The payment will have to be made in cash in PLN or by credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Diners, American Express).

Water and fruit will be available for all players, captains free of charge on the course during the five championship days.

### **PRACTICE FACILITIES**

Driving range, chipping and putting greens will be opened one hour prior to the first tee time each day.

#### **PRAC**TICE DAY

Official practice rounds will take place on Monday, 8 July based on the EGA official draw for practice round. A team player, team captain or advice giver will not be allowed to practice on the championship course for a period of fifteen days prior to the first official practice day, unless he or she is a member of the golf club at which the championship is being played.









### INFORMATION

### CADDIES

A player must not have a caddie other than a fellow team player during the round.

### **PULL TROLLEYS**

Pull trolleys will be available at the golf course.

#### **COURSE GUIDE**

A Course Guide will be available for all players, captains and advisors at the club house.

#### **CEREMONIES**

The Opening Ceremony will be held on Monday, 8 July at the club house. The Closing Ceremony & Farewell Dinner will be held on Saturday, 13 July immediately after the end of all matches.

#### **DRESS CODE**

A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times on the course and in the club house. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course. Team uniforms are requested for ceremonies and the official team photo.

### **GOLF SHOP**

A pro shop is on the premises of Kraków Valley G&GG. The payment will have to be made in cash in PLN or by credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Diners, American Express).

### THE GOLF COURSE

#### **ABOUT THE GOLF COURSE**

Located in the charming surroundings of Ojców National Park, some 35 km from the capital of Małopolska, Kraków Valley G&CC is a facility with a flagship championship par 72 course built to USGA standards, as designed by California architect Ronald Fream. The total length of the white-tee course is 6,532 meters, while the red-tee course is 5,202 m. Topographical diversity, wide, sloping and undulating fairways, deep, strategically placed bunkers and greens that are not flat at any point are the most distinctive features. All these elements combine with a Jurrassic landscape allow the whole complex to aspire to a place among the top European golf courses. Particularly impressive is hole number 10, a par 4 with an out to the right.
