Congratulations to the Top-Ranked Players in the Ladies' European Amateur Ranking 2012. Final results for 2012 (as of 11 September) were:

1	Georgia Hall	England	1787.50 pts
2	Charley Hull	England	1619.44 pts
3	Stephanie Meadow	Ireland	1494.12 pts

Great Britain and Ireland players have taken the three medal places in the 2012 Ladies European Amateur Ranking 2012.

Georgia Hall of England won the 2012 Girls' British Open Amateur and reached the semi-finals in the Ladies' British Open Amateur. She also won the Critchley Salver, the Hampshire Rose and the Roehampton Gold Cup. She was semi-finalist in the Internationaux de France Juniors (Trophee Esmond) and led the team qualifying for the 2012 European Girls' Team Championship with individual scores of 67 & 66 (-11).

Charley Hull of England won the 2012 Harder Invitational in the United States and was selected for the GB&I Curtis Cup Team. Just 15, she played her first Major Professional Championship, the Kraft Nabisco Championship, in which she finished 38th. She has also played on the Ladies' European Tour three times this year, finishing fifth in the Turkish Airlines Ladies' Open and 18th in both the Irish Ladies' Open and the Ladies' British Masters.

Irish player Stephanie Meadow won the 2012 Ladies' British Open Amateur. She started the season helping her University of Alabama team win the NCAA Championship with a success at the Darius Rucker Intercollegiate. She then made her debut appearance in the Curtis Cup and attained the winning point to help GB&I win the match for the first time since 1996. Stephanie also finished runner-up in the Irish Women's Close.
