Congratulations to the Top Ranked Players in the European Amateur Golf Ranking 2010.

Final results for 2010 (as of 31 August) were:

1	Romain Wattel	France	1220.55 pts
2	Andrea Pavan	Italy	1195.77 pts
3	James Byrne	Scotland	1094.55 pts

Wattel's star-studded year commenced with a win in the Junior Orange Bowl Championship and was continued with many strong performances. He won the Coupe Mouchy and the Scottish Open Stroke Play and achieved second place in the Scratch Players' Championship. He played on the winning St Andrews Trophy Continent of Europe team.

Pavan continued what has, up to now, been an exemplary amateur career with a strong 2010 US college season followed by amateur honours in the Italian Open and second place in the European Amateur.

Byrne's performances ensured his selection to represent Europe in the Sir Michael Bonallack Trophy and Great Britain and Ireland in the St Andrews Trophy. Runner-up in the Amateur Championship was a 2010 seasonal highlight.
