RELEVANT INFORMATION

ANTI-DOPING

All players are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping policy (https://www.igfgolf.org/anti-doping).

Any players who are taking medication and are in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the EGA Office no later than 30 days before the start of the Championship.

CADDIES

No caddies are permitted, other than fellow team players.

CAPTAINS MEETING

The Team Captains meeting will take place at 18:00 on the first practice day (Sunday 6 July, TBC). Advice givers are welcome to attend. This will be held in the Hunting Room, located in the clubhouse of Slaley Hall.

A Team Captains and Advisors WhatsApp group will be created through which the Championship Committee will communicate with all teams.

CLOSING CEREMONY AND FAREWELL DINNER

The Closing Ceremony will take place at Slaley Hall at approximately 19:00 on Saturday 12 July, followed by the farewell dinner.

Please note that the dress code is Official Team Dress.

COURSE GUIDES

Tournament Course Guides for Slaley Hall will be included in the Portfolio given to Captains upon Registration. All competing teams are required to inform England Golf as to whether they require course guides in metres or yards by 28 April by email to: <u>championships@englandgolf.org</u>













ELECTRICAL ADAPTORS

Please note that you may need electrical plug adaptors during your stay in England. England operates on plug type G, which has 3 rectangular pins in a triangular pattern.

ENTRIES AND TEAM FEE

Entries and Entry Fee payment must be made via the EGA website before 17:00 CET on Monday 28 April: https://www.ega-golf.ch/entry-forms. (User log in details required)

In addition to the entry fee, each participating team is required to pay a team fee of €2,000 directly to England Golf. The team fee will contribute to the costs of pull trolleys, airport transfers, social events and the farewell dinner. The team fee is for six players and a captain. The cost for additional individuals is €250 per person.

The Team Fee must be paid by Bank Transfer to England Golf no later than 23 June 2025. Please use the reference 'EGTC [+ Federation]' when making the deposit.

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

At registration, each team will receive the Terms of the Competition. Any additional Local Rules will be provided to players at the latest by the starter before the round.

TRANSPORTATION

Transfers will be provided to/from Newcastle Airport.

Should any countries be unable to fly to Newcastle, and are instead intending to fly to Manchester Airport, please contact England Golf (championships@englandgolf.org) as soon as possible. Should there be sufficient demand from Manchester, transfers will be provided.
