Out of Bounds – Rule R18.2

• The boundary of the out of bounds area is defined by the fence marking the limits of the course.

Abnormal Course Conditions – Rule R16.1

- The road from the clubhouse to the green of hole no. 8.
- The gravelled area of the path behind the green of hole no. 5.
- Staked trees: the tree, stake, basin, & plastic protection.
- Poorly healed trenches & any damaged areas located within one club-length of the trench, even if not marked. In the rough, these areas are indicated by blue stakes. Relief is not allowed if there is interference with the player's stance only.
- Cut turf around certain sprinklers. Relief is not allowed if there is interference with the player's stance only.
- Hole 8: The Ground Under Repair (GUR) located in the rough on the left side of the hole & the road are tied & they are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
- Hole 13: The GUR located on the left side & marked by white & green stakes & white & red safety barriers is a No Play Zone with prohibited access (danger). This area extends to infinity. In addition to the relief options provided by rule 16.1, the player may use the nearby Drop Zone (DZ).
- Hole 13: The GUR located in the middle of the hole & marked with blue stakes. In addition to the relief options provided by rule 16.1, the player may use the nearby DZ.
- Hole 14: The GUR located on the left & marked with white & green stakes is a No Play Zone with prohibited access (danger). Relief on the DZ is mandatory. The DZ is the red tee box identified by a red stake cut to fairway height or less.

Integral Parts of the Course

- All roads & paths, except the road from the clubhouse to the green of hole no. 8 & the graveled area of the path behind the green of hole no. 5.
- The graveled area around the clubhouse.
- Wooden planks at the base of the fences defining the course boundaries & the concrete posts in front of these fences.
- The stone wall on the left of hole no. 12.
- Hole no. 13, on the left: the piled-up vegetation.
