Estonia is a highly digital society and the birthplace of global companies such as Bolt, Wise and Skype.


ESTONIAN GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

Estonian Golf & Country Club offers golfers an 18-hole, championship-level Sea Course. Its 9-hole links-style Stone Course will be closed this year to make way for a new 18-hole golf course designed by Annika Sörenstam.

The Sea Course stretches over 6500 meters and is a true championship layout. Set amid unspoiled forests, the holes extend to the coastline and follow the Jägala River.

Featuring an overall elevation change of 40 meters, along with oak-lined fairways, ancient boulders, and natural ponds, the landscape is ideally suited for a world-class golf course.

Due to its length and complexity, the Sea Course presents a serious challenge even for golfers at the highest skill level.

CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

Team captains are asked to register their players at the Tournament Office in the clubhouse on Sunday, July 5, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., or on Monday, July 6, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

CATERING

Breakfast is included in the hotel services and will be served from 6:30 a.m. Players departing earlier in the morning may request a breakfast package.

Lunch will be served at the DaVinci Golf Restaurant at Estonian Golf & Country Club. The lunch voucher costs TBA per person per day. Vouchers for all practice and championship days will be available upon registration. Upon request, the lunch invoice can be issued either prior to the competition or on the first day.

Water and fruit will be provided for all players, captains, and advice givers on the course during the practice rounds and throughout the five championship days.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

The driving range, chipping area, and putting greens will be open daily from 7:00 a.m. for players.

PRACTICE DAYS

Two official practice rounds will take place on Sunday, July 5, and Monday, July 6, in accordance with the EGA official practice round draw.

CADDIES

Caddies are not permitted, except for fellow team players.

RENTAL TROLLEYS

Manual trolleys will be available at the golf course, with trolley handles located at the clubhouse. Players are kindly requested to return their trolleys immediately after completing their rounds so they can be made available to others.

The use of electric trolleys and golf carts is prohibited on all championship days, including the practice rounds.

CEREMONIES

The opening ceremony will take place on Monday, July 6, at the clubhouse of Estonian Golf & Country Club and in its surrounding area, followed by a welcome cocktail reception.

The closing ceremony will be held on Saturday, July 11, after the conclusion of the final match at the 1st tee, followed by a farewell dinner.

The official after-party will be held in Tallinn at Venus Club.

DRESSCODE

A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times, both on the course and in the clubhouse. Jeans, sleeveless or collarless shirts, and tracksuits are not permitted on the course. Only soft spikes are allowed.

Team uniforms are required for ceremonies and official team photos. The welcome and farewell cocktail receptions will be informal.

BAG STORAGE

Golf bags may be stored in players' lockers in the locker room.

LOCKERS

Lockers will be provided for each team and clearly marked with the flags of their respective countries. The lockers will be allocated equally among all participating teams.

INFORMATION BOARDS & DESKS

An information desk will be located in the clubhouse. Players are requested to check the information boards regularly, as important information regarding tee times, messages, transportation, and other relevant matters will be posted there.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be arranged between the airport and the official Tallink City Hotel, as well as between the hotel and the golf club. The detailed transportation schedule will be announced at a later date.

Shuttle services will be provided exclusively for teams staying at the Tallink City Hotel. Teams choosing not to stay at the official hotel will be responsible for arranging and covering the costs of their own transportation.

The team photo session is scheduled for July 6 at 6:30 p.m. at the golf club. The detailed timetable will be provided upon registration.

TRANSPORTATION, HOW TO GET TO THE COURSE

by car: Estonian Golf & Country Club is located approximately 30 minutes from the center of Tallinn. The club can be reached via the St. Petersburg Highway. Follow the signs for EGCC, where a dedicated deceleration lane is provided for the left turn. Continue along the road until you reach the EGCC welcome sign, then turn left in front of the sign to arrive at the club.

by taxi: It is recommended to use apps such as Bolt or Forus.

by official transport: Transportation to and from the official hotel will be provided on team arrival days (Saturday, July 4, and Sunday, July 5) and on the team departure day (Sunday, July 12).

Buses will operate to and from the airport at fixed and convenient intervals, based on the flight information provided by each team in the Travel Form. The detailed schedule will be announced at a later date.

Transportation between the official hotel and the golf course will be provided on all practice and championship days.

The transportation schedule will be published on July 4.
