LOCAL RULES

The following Local Rules will apply in conjunction with the EGA Hard Card, the European Amateur Team Championship Terms of Competition, and the EGA Generic Terms of Competition & Regulations:

ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

1 OUT OF BOUNDS (Rules 18:2)

When white stakes are placed parallel to boundary fences, without white painted lines, the out-of-bounds is defined by the fence.

Beyond the greens of holes 3, 5, 7, 10, and 18, the tees of holes 6 and 11, to the left of hole 13, and to the right of hole 9, the out-of-bounds is defined by the road on the course side (the road/sidewalk is OB).

2 PROTECTIONS OF YOUNG TREES (MLR E-10)

The young trees identified by the tree height does not exceed 2 club lengths or the young tree is supported by stakes, are abnormal course conditions. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1.

3 TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Tee Boards that are situated around the teeing areas. MLR F-23 is in effect.

4 ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rules 16)

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

Artificially surfaced paths or roads, including gravel and traditional Portuguese cobblestone (the wooden poles adjacent to the paths are considered as part of the same immovable obstruction);

Toilets at Loles #5 and #15.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR:

All areas marked with white lines and/or blue stakes on the course.

On the green, there is no interference if the only issue is with the player's stance.

RELIEF FROM TREE ROOTS – MODEL LOCAL RULE F-9 IN EFFECT

If a ball is in the general area and there is interference from exposed tree roots in the fairway or within the general area cut to fairway height, or in the rough up to 3 club-lengths from the edge of the fairway cut, the roots are considered ground under repair. The player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b.

Note: There is no relief if the only interference is with the player's stance.

5 MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Advertising panels (please return them to their place after moving them).

6 PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

DROP ZONES – Holes #8 and #16

If a ball is in the penalty area of holes 8 and/or 16, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball not found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each with one penalty stroke:

a. Take relief under Rule 17.1; or

b. As an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the drop zone marked "DZ", located to the right of the penalty area.

EVACUATION PLAN

1 Prolonged note of a siren – Immediate Stop for imminent danger. The plan outlined above applies.

3 consecutive notes of siren – Stop for non-dangerous situation. Players must remain in their positions on the field, as this is a temporary and non-dangerous situation.

Resumption of Play – 2 consecutive notes of siren
