PROVISIONAL ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

THESE LOCAL RULES ARE IN ADDITION TO THE EGA LOCAL RULES & TERMS OF COMPETITION 2026 HARD CARD

1. Out Of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

Defined by walls, fences, dots and white stakes that define the boundaries of the course.

If stakes and white lines coexist to mark the out of bounds, the stakes identify and the lines define it.

Note:

a) The area of the football field to the right of the 8th fairway as defined by the wooden fence.

b) Beyond the fence behind the 8th green.

A ball coming to rest on or beyond the public path behind the 8th green is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.

c) Beyond the fence to the right of the 9th.

d) The practice ground as defined by the stakes supporting the protection net. Where the protection net ends, the boundary is defined by white lines.

e) The Clubhouse as defined by white posts and adjoining white lines and the wooden railings to the right of the 1st tee.

f) Beyond the posts to the right of the 1st and right of 4th hole and the rear of green 6.

2. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16)

a. Immovable Obstructions

- Staked trees. **NOTE:** The mature trees **supported** by **LARGE** sleepers/supports are integral parts of the course and relief under Rule 16.1b is available from the sleeper/support **ONLY** (i.e.: not the tree).
- All concrete and tarmac roads are immovable obstructions.

b. Ground Under Repair (GUR)

- If the player's ball lies in the general area cut to fairway height or less and there is interference from exposed tree roots the tree roots are treated as GUR. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. But relief is not allowed if the tree roots **ONLY** interfere with the player's stance.

3. Integral Objects

All non-asphalted or non-concreted paths (including those covered with gravel)

Penalty for breaching of these Local Rules: General Penalty

PLAY OFF HOLES Hole by hole on 1st & 4th - Girls, 16th, 17th & 18th - Boys until a winner is decided.

RECORDING AREA

Please return your scorecard immediately after play to the recording area located in the Tournament office.

LIVE SCORING Holes 3, 6, 9, 12, 15 and 18.

WATER STATIONS Holes 1, 5, 10 and 14.

Water fountains are located between green 6 and tee 7, and to the right of tee 12.

TOILETS Located near green 4, tee 15, hole 17 and the Pro Shop/locker rooms between holes 9 and 10.
