

2023 EUROPEAN GIRLS' TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP
ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

These Local Rules are applicable in addition to the EGA Hard Card. For this championship, they replace all Local Rules previously published by the Hossegor Golf Club.

1. 1st tee

For the purposes of Rule 5.3a the first tee area is deemed to be the portion of the championship tee cut to fairway height.

2. Out of Bounds

- A) Beyond any wall, fence or the course side edge of white line so defining the boundary of the course.
- B) At Hole Number 2 & 7 the boundary is defined by the inside edge of the wall.
- C) The clubhouse and surrounding paved areas are out of bounds and defined by concrete edge of the paving on the course side.
- D) The power station and tennis courts on Hole 15 is out of bounds
- E) The river in front of the 3rd tee and on the left-hand side of Hole 3 is out of bounds
- F) The river on the left-hand side of Holes 4 and 5 is out of bounds
- G) Practice area right of 10, 11, & 12 fairway is out of bounds.

3. Abnormal Course Conditions (including Immovable Obstructions)

- A) Artificially surfaced roads. Where artificially surfaced roads have wooden surrounds, they are treated as a single abnormal course condition when taking relief under Rule 16.1
- B) If a player's ball is in the area left of Hole 14 marked by white lines and identified by blue stakes (no play zone), including when it is known or virtually certain to be in that area even though not found, the player MUST take relief in the dropping zone provided identified by a white stake.
- C) The areas left of the 1st and 17th greens, identified by white dots, are Ground Under Repair.

4. Penalty area at the back of 3rd green

If a player's ball is in the penalty area at the back of the 3rd green including when it is known or virtually certain to be in the penalty area even though not found, the player has these relief options each for a penalty of one stroke.

- The player may take relief under Rule 17.1 OR
- As an extra option the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone provided identified by white line and white stake. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3

5. Integral Objects

All natural paths.

6. Practice putting green

The practice putting green behind the 18 Green is a wrong putting green and relief must be taken under Rule 13.1f

7. Temporary Immovable Obstruction

A player may take relief from TIOs in accordance with Model Local Rule F-23 or as an additional option (available only if a player chooses not to operate under Rule 16.1), the player may lift the ball and drop it on either side of the TIO.

Penalty for breach of Local Rule General Penalty

Additional Information

Drinking water on the course is located beside the 1st tee and between Holes 5 & 6, 9 & 10, 12 & 13 and 15 & 16.
Toilets are located at 9th Green, 10 Tee, 12 Green & 15 Green.
