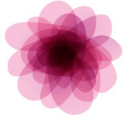

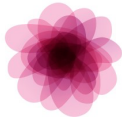
ABOUT ICELAND

Some facts about Iceland:

- Iceland is an island in the North Atlantic. Travel times to Iceland by air are between 2,5 to 4 hours from most of the major airports in Europe. The population of Iceland is only about 350.000. Icelanders speak Icelandic although most can understand and speak English. The currency is Icelandic Krona, ISK. Conversion rate at the time of writing is 1000 ISK= 7 EUR.

The first known settlers in Iceland arrived on the Island around the year 875 from Norway and by 930 the settlers had established a parliament to establish rules and solve conflicts. Up until the second World War Iceland was under either Norwegian and later under Danish rule. In 1944 Iceland became a republic.





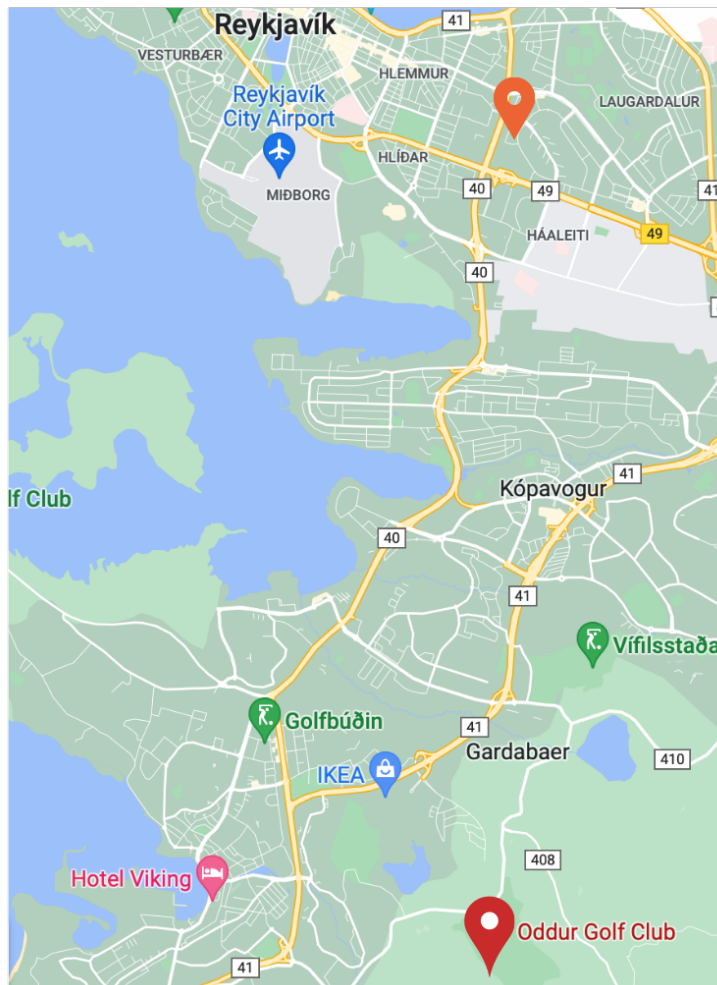

HOW TO GET THERE

- Keflavik Airport is the nearest international airport. It takes appr. 50 minutes to travel by bus to the official hotel (Grand Hotel Reykjavik)
- Bus transportation from and to Keflavik Airport will be arranged for teams arriving on 2nd and 3rd of July and leaving on the 10th of July from the official hotel
- The travel time from the official hotel to Oddur Golf Club is appr. 20 minutes. A shuttle bus service will be provided between the official hotel and the golf course. Pick-up times will be posted on the notice boards at the golf club and at the official hotel, as well as on the Championship website.

THE VENUE AND COURSE

Iceland as a golf destination is a well kept secret in the golfing world. With over 60 golf clubs and 20.000 members, Iceland has a lot to offer for the golf enthusiast. One of the gems in this flora of golf courses is Oddur Golf Club.

It is located in the municipality of Garðabær, in the outskirts of Reykjavík. It only takes 20 minutes to drive to Oddur Golf Club, from Reykjavik city center. The club operates two courses, Urriðavöllur, 18 hole championship course and Ljúflingur, a 9 hole par 3 course. Urriðavöllur championship golf course is a challenging 5.900 m, par 71. The Championship course is a heathland course flanked by lava from the dormant volcano Búrfell. Officially opened in 1997 it quickly established itself as one of the best courses in Iceland and is a regular venue on the Icelandic Amateur Tour. Oddur Golf Club hosted the European Ladies' Team Championship in 2016.

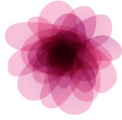

FACILITES

The clubhouse, which overlooks the eighteenth and the ninth green, features a bar and a restaurant. You can enjoy light snacks or full meals in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere. The Pro Shop and changing rooms are also located in the clubhouse.

The practice facilities include a 16 bay driving range, two putting greens and a bunkered chipping green near the club house.

It is likely that forward teeing areas will be used on hole number 14 during the championship. In the event of strong winds some holes might be shortened depending on wind direction.

CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

ENTRIES

BAG STORAGE

There is no bag storage facilities at the host club. Competitors will be required to take their clubs back to their rooms each day

PRACTICE FACILITIES

A practice putting green, bunker practice and chipping area and full driving range are available next to the Clubhouse. Tournament packages for players include unlimited range balls and a pull trolley for the championship week.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

The official practice days are on the 3rd and 4th of July. Tee times will be allocated by the EGA Championship Committee.

CATERING

The kitchen will be open one hour before the first tee time and through to the course of play. Additionally, breakfast will be available and included at the official hotel. There will be a special menu in place during the championship, any specific dietary requirements and allergies can be included in the team list or with the club upon arrival.

CLUBHOUSE

Dressing rooms are available at the club house without lockers. Please note that they are small and players are encouraged to change at the hotel.

DRESS CODE

A reasonable standard of dress is expected at all times, both on the course and in the clubhouse. Jeans, sleeveless or collarless shirts and tracksuits are not permitted on the course. The welcome and farewell cocktail parties will be informal. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course. The dress code for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies is the national team "ceremonial" dress.

INFORMATION BOARDS

There will be information boards located in the club house and the reception areas of the official hotel. Players should have a look at the information boards at regular intervals as important information will be displayed relating to tee-times, messages etc. The information will also be published on the official website of the tournament, <https://www.ega-golf.ch/content/european-girls-team-championship-0>

INTERNET ACCESS

A complimentary wireless internet access is available in the clubhouse area and in the official hotel.

REGISTRATION AND TOURNAMENT OFFICE

Registration is open from Sunday 3rd of July, from 8:00 a.m. at the Tournament Office. Teams are requested to register at the club house immediately on arrival, but not later than Monday 4th of July, 12:00 p.m. (midday). A team failure to meet the deadline or to pre-notify the Committee of his pending arrival time may result in the team losing its starting field place reservation. Tournament office is open from 7:00 a.m. until one hour after end of play each day during the championship.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be organised between Keflavik Airport and the official hotel, Grand Hotel Reykjavik, as well as between the hotel and the golf club. The schedule will be established at a further date. If you wish to take advantage of organised transportation kindly complete the Travel Detail Form and send back by 31st of May 2022.



ACCOMMODATION

The Grand Hotel Reykjavik is the official hotel of the championship. Grand Hotel Reykjavik is a four star hotel. For further information visit the hotel website.



Please note that only 20 rooms are reserved for July 2 at the official hotel, first come, first serve. Those who do not get a room that night will have to take care of accommodation for that night by themselves.

90 rooms have been reserved at Grand Hotel, from July 3 until July 10. **The rooms are reserved at the following rates, until May 8th 2022 (Booking code: EGTC22).** After that availability and rates may change.

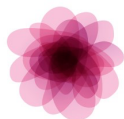
