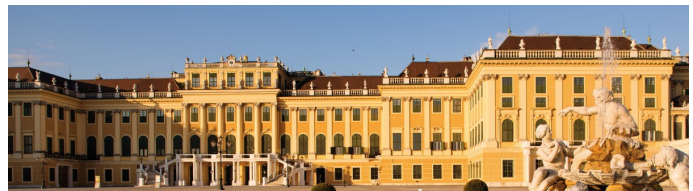

## WORTH VISITING:

### Schönbrunn Palace, Vienna

The former summer residence of the Habsburgs impresses with imperial ceremonial rooms and magnificent gardens. Today, due to its historical significance, its unique layout and magnificent furnishings, the palace is a UNESCO World Heritage site.



Schönbrunn Palace park is open to visitors free of charge all year round and is home to impressive fountains, statues, monuments, trees and flowers as well as the magnificent Gloriette. The Imperial Carriage Museum, Crown Prince Garden, Orangery Garden, Maze & Labyrinth, Zoo, Palm House and Desert Experience House are also part of the palace park and can be visited for an admission fee.

### Museums, Vienna

Vienna has more museums and galleries of international reputation. The "Kunsthistorisches Museum Vienna" (e.g.) with the world's largest collection of Bruegel paintings, MuseumsQuartier with Leopold Museum (Schiele), Museum Moderner Kunst (Museum of Modern Art), Architekturzentrum (Architectural Center) and Kunsthalle rank among the city's most important cultural venues. The Albertina is home to the world's largest collection of graphic arts and prints (60,000 drawings, 1 million prints).

### The Wachau Valley

The **Wachau Valley** is a particularly scenic stretch of the **Danube River** running through Lower Austria in the country's northeast. The valley is bookmarked by the towns of **Krems** (29 kilometers, approx. 30 minutes car ride) to the north and **Melk** (62 kilometers, approx. 45 minutes car ride) to the south and is a popular spot for a day trip. The Wachau Valley is actually a UNESCO heritage listed site due to its natural landscape, agriculture and architecture. Agriculturally, it is renowned for its locally produced apricots and wine.

## **Dürnstein Village (35 kilometers, approx. 35 minutes car ride)**

Just up the Danube River from Krems is the small, picturesque town of **Dürnstein**. The tiny town really is a charming spot to visit. You can cross from one end of town to the other in under 10 minutes. Lining the main street are plenty of quaint houses and it is easy to feel as if you've stepped back to a simpler time.

Dürnstein is another well-known wine growing area which becomes apparent as you pass many fields of grapes as you enter the town. There are some great traditional restaurants to eat at.



The biggest landmark of Dürnstein and its claim to fame are the **castle ruins** that rest above the town. These ruins are of significant historic value. While the climb up the rocky trail to the castle ruins may be fairly tough, it is also very rewarding. Not only do you get to wander about the old ruins, but you get to appreciate the fantastic view they have of the entire valley. Sticking above the rooftops of the town is the blue tower of Dürnstein Abbey, but you can also see out towards neighbouring towns like Weißenkirchen.

## **Wine tasting**

In the wine region of Lower Austria, it's not just wine shops that present their precious treasures in a contemporary look, 'worlds of wine' such the Loisium in Langenlois or Sandgrube 13 in Krems show that wine, as a traditional drink, definitely deserves a contemporary and cool presentation. Learn about wine in the **LOISIUM WeinErlebnisWelt & Vinothek in Langenlois** (<https://www.loisium.com/en/weinwelt-langenlois/business-events/>) wine experience in a very modern way. Grape juice is creatively celebrated with the use of lighting, sound effects, animations and exhibits. Audio guides are available in English, French, Italian, Spanish, Hungarian, Czech, Polish and Russian.

The Winzer Krems winemaking community also presents the best of Kremser wine in an entertaining way, in **Sandgrube 13 wein.sinn.** (<https://www.winzerkrems.at/en/>) Foreign language tours are only available in English, and with prior reservation.

## **The Castle Grafenegg**

Seven centuries of history can be seen in the architecture of Grafenegg Castle. Extended in the 19th century, it has become Austria's most important example of historicism. Here you can find stylistic traces from Gothic through Baroque and Biedermeier to elegant Neo-gothic.

Grafenegg Castle has gone a long way from the mill on the Kamp river to becoming an international festival venue. On their guided castle tour you will get informed about the construction and the architectural features of the castle. On the park tour you can learn more about the 19th-century landscape garden and its characteristics as well as about the original baroque garden.

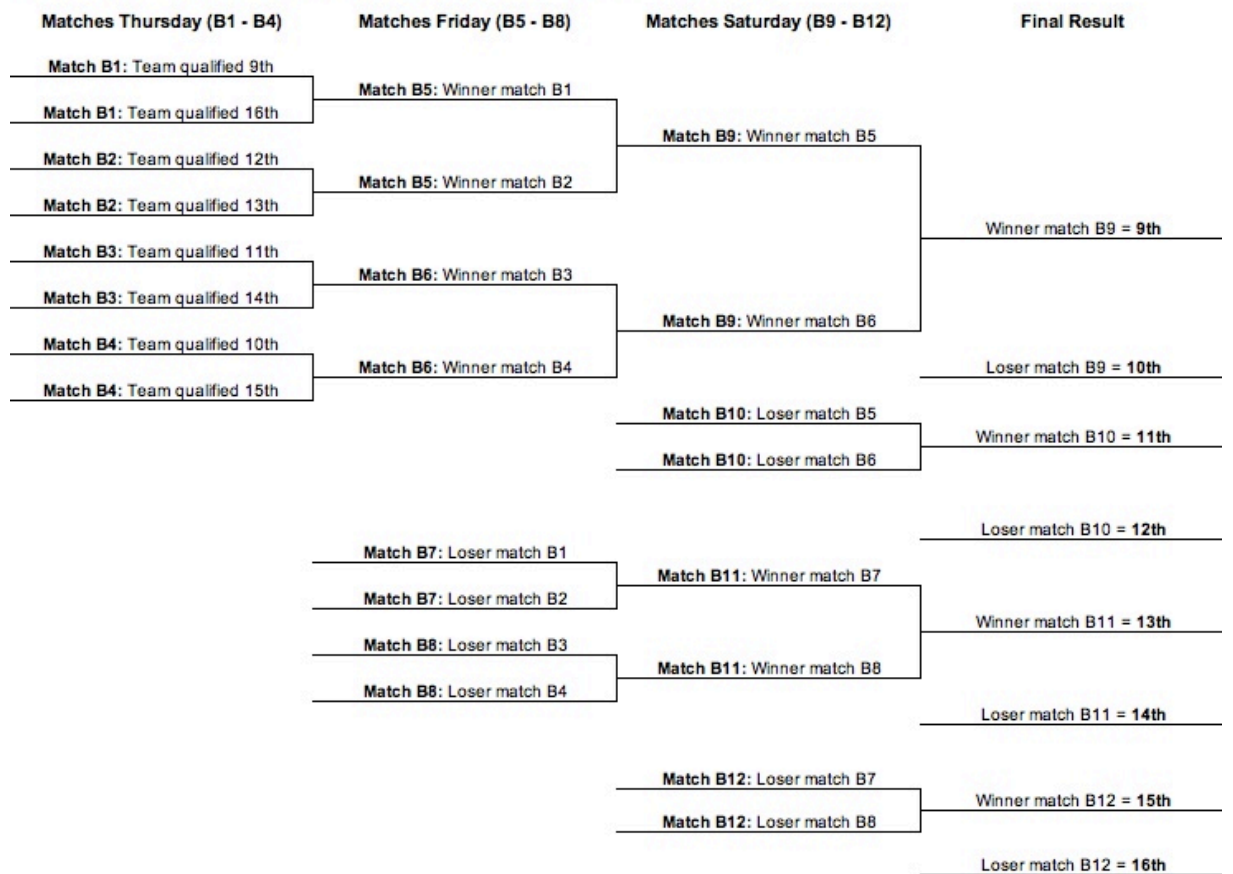

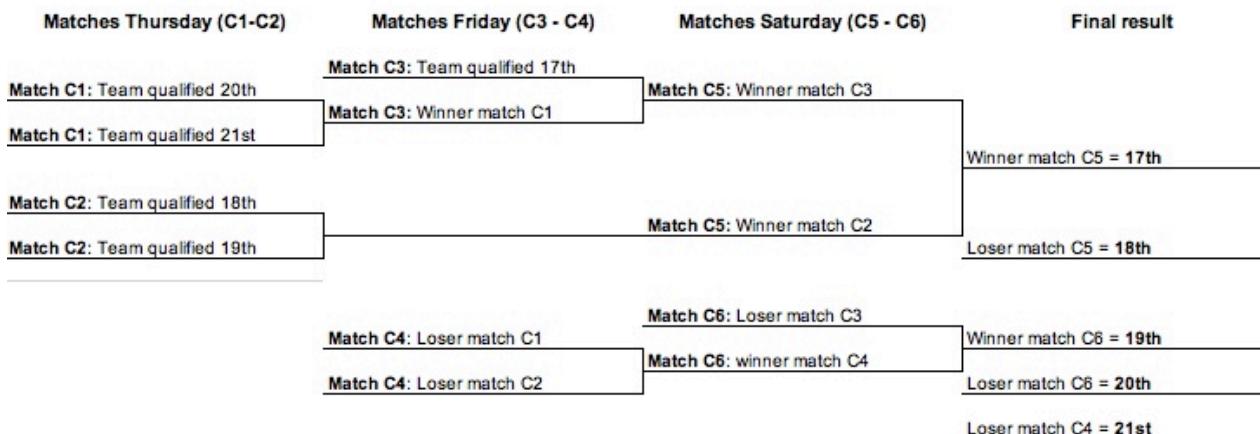
