About Switzerland

Some facts about Switzerland:

Switzerland, officially the Swiss Confederation, is a federal republic in Europe. It consists of 26 cantons, and the city of Bern is the seat of the federal authorities. The country is situated in Western-Central Europe, and is bordered by Italy to the south, France to the west, Germany to the north, and Austria and Liechtenstein to the east. Switzerland is a landlocked country geographically divided between the Alps, the Swiss Plateau and the Jura.

While the Alps occupy the greater part of the territory, the Swiss population of approximately eight million people is concentrated mostly on the plateau, where the largest cities are to be found: among them are the two global cities and economic centres Zürich and Geneva. There are four official languages in Switzerland, by order of importance German, French, Italian and Romansh. The currency used is Switzerland is the Swiss Franc (CHF)



Geneva

Geneva, or Genève in French, is the secondmost populous city in Switzerland (after Zürich) and the most populous city of the French-speaking part of Switzerland. Situated in the southwest of the country, where the Rhône exits Lake Geneva, it is the capital of the Republic and Canton of Geneva.

Geneva is a global city, a financial centre, and a worldwide centre for diplomacy due to the presence of numerous international organizations, including the headquarters of many agencies of the United Nations and the

Red Cross. Geneva hosts the highest number of international organizations in the world. It is also where the Geneva Conventions were signed, which chiefly concern the treatment of wartime non-combatants and prisoners of war. Together with, for instance, New York City (global headquarters of the UN), Basel (Bank for International Settlements), and Strasbourg (Council of Europe), Geneva is a city serving as the headquarters of one of the most important international organizations, without being the capital of a country.













THE VENUE

Founded in 1922, the Geneva Golf Club is located in the commune of Vandoeuvres at the top of the Cologny hillside. The current course was designed in 1973 by the famous architect Robert Trent Jones

Senior in the exceptional wooded park of Bessinge. From 2016 to 2018, a complete renovation was carried out, according to a plan by Robert Trent Jones Junior.

The first holes offer a view of the City of Geneva, its Jet d'eau and Lake Geneva. On the south side, the view of the Alps and Mont Blanc is unobstructed.

Internationally renowned, the Geneva Golf Club has notably hosted the European Junior Championship in 1975, the World Amateur Ladies Championship



in 1982 and several editions of the Swiss Internationals. Over years it hosted the Rolex Trophy, a major stage of the European Challenge Tour and in 2022 the Geneva Golf Club hosted the Arnold Palmer Cup.

The only 18-hole golf course in the canton of Geneva, the Golf Club de Genève is located ten minutes from the city centre and thirty minutes from Geneva International Airport, it is easily accessible by road.

The facilities include beside the 18-hole championship course, a covered driving range, several putting greens as well as areas for short game and bunker practice.

ENTRIES

BAG STORAGE

A golf bag storage is located at the Clubhouse. It is open daily from 6:30 a.m. to 9 p.m.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

A practice putting green, bunker practice and a short game area and a driving range are available (see map). Tournament packages for players include unlimited range balls and a pull trolley for the championship week.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

The official practice days are Sunday 9 and Monday 10 July. Tee times are allotted to each team by the EGA office. The EGA might consider the time of arrival by plane.

CATERING

The Clubhouse's restaurant will be available for players and their guests for dining and resting. There will also be a Food Truck for snacks near the 18th Green.

CEREMONIES

Monday 10 July 7pm – Official Opening followed by a Welcome cocktail reception at the clubhouse Saturday 15 July 5pm – Prize giving ceremony, followed by the farewell cocktail party at the clubhouse.











CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse with dressing rooms, restaurant etc. will be open daily from 6:30am till 10pm.

DRESS CODE

A reasonable standard of dress is expected at all times, both on the course and in the clubhouse. Jeans, sleeveless or collarless shirts and tracksuits are not permitted. The welcome and farewell cocktail parties will be formal. Players are requested to wear the official outfit for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.

Only soft spikes are permitted on the course.

INFORMATION BOARDS

Information boards will be located in the club house and the reception areas of the official hotels. Players should have a look at the information boards at regular intervals as important information will be displayed relating to tee-times, messages etc. The information will also be published on the official website of the tournament.

INTERNET ACCESS

A complimentary wireless internet access is available in the clubhouse area. Check the infoboard for access.

LOCKERS

The locker rooms are situated (insert location). Two lockers for personal belongings will be made available to each Team.

REGISTRATION AND TOURNAMENT OFFICE

Registration is open from Sunday 9 July 7:30am.

Teams are requested to register at the club house immediately on arrival, but not later than Sunday 9 July 7:30pm.


