MESSAGE FROM THE GOLF DE CHANTILLY PRESIDENT



We are grateful to the European Golf Association and the French Golf Federation for having invited Golf de Chantilly to host the 2023 Jacques Léglise Trophy.

The annual Boys' Match between Great Britain & Ireland and the Continent of Europe has been contested since 1977 in memory of Jacques Léglise. The trophy was donated by Jean-Louis Dupont, who was President of Golf de Chantilly for many years.

Jacques Léglise was a French internal player who came from Bordeaux and joined Golf de Chantilly in the mid 1930s. In 1937 he won the French close and the international amateur championships.

He served as a most active and popular President of the French Golf Association between 1951 and 1967. He was also President of the European Golf Association from 1951 to 1953, and Chairman of the EGA Amateur Technical Committee from 1958 to 1973, a period during which many of the EGA's championships and international matches were initiated.

It is therefore a special pleasure for the Committee and members of Golf de Chantilly to welcome both teams as well as our visiting friends from The R&A and the FGA.

We hope that players will have a great time and play their best golf on our Vineuil course.














DRESS CODE
