Venue

Golflcub Hösel e.V.

With 1500 members, GC Hösel in Heiligenhaus is one of the largest golf clubs in the DGV. With two 18-hole championship courses, the family-friendly Bundesliga club is situated in a quiet location in the middle of the Düsseldorf, Duisburg, Mülheim and Essen metropolitan area. With strategically positioned bunkers, extensive roughs, biotopes and slight slopes, the south course challenges golfers with a variety of playing techniques to match their strengths.

The north course, designed by Simon Gidman, was opened in 1997 in the slightly hilly valley basin between the clubhouse and the Höselberg. Acceptable slopes and open vegetation convey an "ease" at first glance, which quickly turns into a challenging task when encountering the natural roughs and interesting and technically modern greens.

However, a clear all-round view of neighboring fairways and the modern clubhouse quickly make up for any minor sporting mishaps. In 2016, we were the first golf club in Germany to receive the seal of approval for accessibility in golf.

Germany – Nordrhein-Westfalen

Heiligenhaus is a town of Nordrhein-Westfalen in the Düsseldorf administrative district. It is located in the city triangle Düsseldorf–Essen–Wuppertal in the "Niederbergisches Land".

Climate

The climate is mild and generally warm and temperate. There is significant rainfall throughout the year in Heiligenhaus. Even the driest month still shows high rainfall. The average annual temperature in Heiligenhaus is 10.2 °C. The warmest month in Heiligenhaus is July. The average temperature in July is 18.4 °C.
