



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS (CODE OF CONDUCT):

THIS DOCUMENT MUST BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 2020 EGA CHAMPIONSHIP COVID19 GUIDELINES. PLAYERS MUST FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE SIGNS EXHIBITED, IN PARTICULAR:

- VISITORS AND PLAYERS MUST ENTER THE RECEPTION ONE AT A TIME,
- **PROTECTIVE MASKS MUST BE WORN INSIDE AT ALL TIMES..**
- ALL MUST OBSERVE SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES, **THAT IS 2 METRES** AND GATHERINGS ARE DISCOURAGED AT THE DRIVING RANGE OR IN THE AREAS AROUND THE CLUBHOUSE,
- ACCOMPANYING PERSONS (COACHES, PARENTS, COMPETITORS' GUARDIANS) MUST KEEP APPROPRIATE DISTANCE (**MINIMUM 25 METERS**) TO COMPETITORS ON THE GOLF COURSE,
- THE DISTANCE BETWEEN GROUPS MUST BE 10 MINUTES OR 100 METERS ALL THE TIME,
- PASSING THE FLIGHT IN FRONT IS NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CASE,
- WHEN THE TEE OF THE NEXT HOLE IS NOT FREE, COMPETITORS MUST NOT APPROACH THAT TEE AND HAVE TO WAIT AT A DISTANCE OF 20 METERS UNTIL THE TEE IS FREE FOR PLAYING,
- SOCIAL DISTANCING ALSO APPLIES WHEN SEARCHING FOR A BALL,
- RENTAL OR EXCHANGE OF EQUIPMENT BETWEEN PLAYERS IS NOT PERMITTED (LASERS, BALLS, TOWELS...).
- BREACHES OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE SUBJECT EITHER TO SLOVENIAN LAW OR THE EGA DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE, WHICHEVER IS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE, AND MAY INCLUDE DISQUALIFICATION FOR SERIOUS BREACHES

COVID19 ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

These Local Rules are applicable in addition to the EGA Hard Card and the CUBO Golf Additional Local Rules for the championship.

I. SCORE IN STROKE PLAY (RULE 3.3B) is modified as follows:

Players must record their own scores on their scorecard. A marker will be appointed by the Committee, the marker must also record the score of the player on her own scorecard. During "Recording", it is sufficient for the marker to approve the score verbally.

II. CADDIE RESTRICTION (Model Local Rule H1)

Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule:

- The player gets the **general penalty** for each hole during which she is helped by a caddie.
- If the breach happens or continues between two holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole.

III. THE FLAGSTICK (RULE 13.2) is modified as follows:

It is not allowed to remove the flagstick or to touch it purposefully by hand.

Keeping it upright with a golf club is allowed if desired (to center the flagstick which may be leaning to the disadvantage of the player).

The hole will usually have an insert that reduces the depth of the cup to about half.

Penalty for Breach this Local Rule: first breach: warning / second breach: General Penalty / third breach: Disqualification).

IV. TREATING MOVABLE OBJECTS TO BE IMMOVABLE (Model Local Rule F-18)

All stakes (including distance signs), except boundary stakes, on the course are treated as Immovable Obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. Relief is not allowed to be taken under Rule 15.2. **If the ball lies in penalty area, no relief is available.**

V. PREFERRED LIES IN BUNKERS (Model Local Rule E-3)

If a player's ball is in a bunker, the player may once place the original ball or another ball in the bunker without penalty. This area may not be improved before placing and must meet the following requirements:

- Reference point: spot of the original ball.
- Size of the area: one club length from the reference point, but with the following limitations:
 - this area must be not closer to the hole than the reference point, and
 - this area must be in the bunker.

Players are requested to level their footsteps in the bunker with their feet as much as possible.
